RULES OF ENTRY

Open to anyone living, working or at school within a 3 mile radius of Manor Park, Shepperton (the site of the Fair) who is not connected with the Fair Committee or the support team, and who has no commercial interest in photography either as a professional or an amateur.

Each entrant can enter a total of 6 images.

Images must have been taken by the entrant and must not have been previously entered into this competition.

Entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form (overleaf) and the fee (cheques payable to "Shepperton Village Fair"). Please also see below about return of prints.

Images can be in black & white or colour from film or digital original.

Entries using this form must be submitted as prints mounted on a white card mount with a surround no more than 2cm. The total size is to be to a maximum 25 x 30cm.

All prints will be displayed until the Fair closes at 5pm on 8th June and can only be collected after this time from Manor Park until 6.30pm. Any images not collected by 6.30pm, the entrants will be contacted by the organisers to arrange return or you can give us an SAE with your entry for return.

Judging will be by an appointed panel and the judges decision will be final in all matters, including interpretation of these rules.

The Shepperton Village Fair committee and the Sponsor reserve the right to use your submitted images for promotional and marketing purposes, without payment and with a credit. The competition sponsor may wish to use some entries for publication in the Village Matters magazines. Your details may therefore be passed onto the sponsor for this purpose only. If you do not wish for your details to be used in this way please advise the Photographic Competition Organiser.

Neither the Shepperton Village Fair committee nor any sponsors shall be responsible for any loss or damage in respect of any entry.
